

EUROPEAN AQUATICS JUNIOR DIVING CHAMPIONSHIPS

(UPDATED 28 September 2024)

In addition to the European Aquatics General Event Rules the following

REGULATIONS

shall apply

J-D 1 ORGANISATION

J-D 1.1 The Championships shall be held every year.

J-D 1.2 The organising Member Federation, the date and the place where the Championships will be held shall be decided by the European Aquatics Bureau and circulated by the European Aquatics Office.

J-D 1.3 One (1) Bureau Delegate to be appointed by the Bureau and up to seven (7) members of the European Aquatics Technical Diving Committee (TDC) appointed by the TDC will be responsible for and supervise the organisation of the event and conduction of the competitions according to European Aquatics Rules and Regulations.

From the seven (7) members the European Aquatics, TDC shall appoint the Technical Delegate for each event and other delegates in capacity of Referee, Assistant Referee, Observers and other officials supervising key sections of competitions conductions.

The Bureau Delegate and the appointed members of the TDC will decide on all matters arising on site at the competitions which require an immediate decision.

J-D 2 EVENTS & PARTICIPATION

J-D 2.1 Age Groups are (boys and girls):

- a) Category "A": 16 to 18 years;
- b) Category "B": 14 to 15 years.

J-D 2.2 Events are (boys and girls):

Individual Diving:

- a) Category "A":
 - Springboard 1m;
 - Springboard 3m;
 - Platform 5m - 7.5m - 10m.
- b) Category "B":
 - Springboard 1m;



- Springboard 3m;
- Platform 5m - 7.5m - 10m.

Synchronised Diving:

Category "A/B combined": Springboard 3 m & Platforms 5m - 7,5m - 10m (if the facility permits)

Junior Mixed Team Event:

Category "A/B Boys/Girls combined" Springboard 3m and Platforms 5m - 7,5m - 10m

- J-D 2.3 In individual diving events two (2) entries per Federation and per event may be submitted.
- J-D 2.4 In synchronised diving events and Junior Mixed Team Event: one (1) team per Federation may be entered.
- J-D 2.5 The Competition Schedule will be decided by the European Aquatics TDC and circulated by the European Aquatics Office.

J-D 3 FORMAT

J-D 3.1 Entries will be accepted regardless of standards.

J-D 3.2 The events will be held according to the World Aquatics Diving Age Group Rules (Categories A and B).

J-D 3.3 Format for the Junior Mixed Team Event:

Juniors Mixed Team Event is composed of minimum 1 male and 1 female up to 4 (four) divers (mixed boys and girls of A and B Age groups (at least 1 from B present))

For the judging of two mixed synchro dives in Mixed Team Event, the Officials are the same those performed in individual rounds and score the dive with one mark according to the overall impression of the dive.

In case of a Tie in the preliminaries, all tied divers or teams up to and including placed twelfth (12th) will qualify to the finals.

J-D 4 ENTRIES

- J-D 4.1 Preliminary Entries shall be submitted to the organising Federation, with copy to the European Aquatics Office, no later than the date circulated by the European Aquatics Office.
- J-D 4.2 A Federation having made a Preliminary Entry may withdraw up to the date circulated by the European Aquatics Office.



J-D 4.3 Named Entries shall be submitted to the organising Federation, with copy to the European Aquatics Office, no later than ten (10) days before the first day of the competition, if not announced otherwise.

J-D 4.4 Competitors who cannot prove identity, age and citizenship shall not be permitted to take part in the competitions.

J-D 5 ACCREDITATION

J-D 5.1 Federations entering the Championships will receive accreditation for:

- a) the President of the Federation;
- b) the Head of the Delegation;
- c) the entered competitors;
- d) one medical person; a second medical person in case more than fifteen competitors have been entered;
- e) team staff members:
 - 5 for up to 5 competitors;
 - 6 for up to 8 competitors;
 - 7 for more than 8 competitors.

However, the number of team staff members may not exceed the number of competitors plus one.

J-D 5.2 Team staff members include everybody servicing the team:
Team Leaders, Chaperones, Coaches, Physiotherapists, Interpreters, etc., but not officials such as judges, referees, etc.



J-D 6 AWARDS

- J-D 6.1 Medals will be awarded to the competitors placed first, second and third in each event.
- J-D 6.2 Diplomas will be awarded to the competitors placed 1st to 8th.
- J-D 6.3 In case of a Tie in the final all tied divers or teams will be ranked at the same place.

J-D 7 OFFICIALS

- J-D 7.1 Acting Diving Officials (Judges) are not allowed to act as coaches or to represent in any other capacity and/or Function in their Member Federation throughout the actual Championships. Officials who do not respect this Regulation shall be excluded from the Championships.
- J-D 7.2 The TDC shall appoint the Referee, the Assistant Referee the judges panel(s) from the Diving Officials approved and the other officials for each event.
- J-D 7.3 Federations may nominate one (1) or two (2) Diving Officials qualified on the current European Aquatics List Level 3.

Level 2 could be submitted and confirmed by the TDC if meets competence requirements: no less than two years of practice with assessments averaged above 95%, with no events below 90% in 3 competitions (minimum 4 events in each), at least 2 of which are international; Level 2 or 3 Educational or Refreshment Courses valid required.
- J-D 7.4 Federations entering four (4) divers or more are obliged to nominate at least one (1) Diving Official qualified on the current European Aquatics List Level 3 (preference) and/or Level 2 complying with competence stated in J-D-7.3.
- J-D 7.4.1 A Federation obliged by the Rule J-D 7.4, but not succeeded to nominate a Diving Official in the categories prescribed shall be financially responsible for one (1) Diving Official to be nominated by the TDC, if available, different from countries has already entered their officials qualified.

Officials of the Level 3 on the current European Aquatics List are in preference. Officials of the Level 2 complying with competence stated in J-D-7.3 could be considered.

In case more than one Member Federation obliged but didn't nominate a Diving Official in the Levels prescribed, then minimum required number of judges to conduct the Championships will be nominated by the TDC on costs shared by those Member Federations, who failed to nominate Diving Officials to the Rule J-D 7.4 accordingly. Travel economy class, accommodation and lodging are to be covered.
- J-D 7.5 Nominations shall be submitted to the European Aquatics Office no later than the date circulated by the European Aquatics Office.
- J-D 7.6 Officials approved by the TDC are on the costs of the nominating Federation.
- J-D 7.7 The Organising Federation shall supply all other Officials.
- J-D 7.8 Acting Diving Officials shall be evaluated.
