**EUROPEAN AQUATICS
JUNIOR HIGH DIVING CHAMPIONSHIPS
(UPDATED 15 MARCH 2025)**

In addition to the European Aquatics General Event Rules
THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS
shall apply:

J-HD 1 ORGANISATION

- J-HD 1.1** The European Junior High Diving Championships shall be held every year.
- J-HD 1.2** The organising Federation and the location of the Championships will be decided by the European Aquatics Bureau and circulated by the European Aquatics Office.
- J-HD 1.3** One (1) Delegate of the European Aquatics Bureau to be appointed by the Bureau and three (3) members of the European Aquatics Technical High Diving Committee (THDC) shall be responsible for and supervise the organisation of the event according to European Aquatics Rules and Regulations.
The Bureau Delegate and three (3) members of the THDC will be responsible for all matters relating to the delivery of a successful Junior High Diving Event for European Aquatics.

J-HD 2 EVENTS

- J-HD 2.1** Events are:
a) Category A: 15m
b) Category B: 12m
- J-HD 2.2** The order of events will be as decided by the European Aquatics THDC, subject to the approval of the European Aquatics Executive, and circulated by the European Aquatics Office.
- J-HD 2.3** The four events shall be organised in a two (2) days' program, if not announced otherwise.
Day 1: Age Group B boys and Age Group A girls
Day 2: Age Group B girls and Age Group A boys

J-HD 3 PARTICIPATION

- J-HD 3.1** Groups are (girls and boys):
a) Category A: 17-18 or 19 years
b) Category B: 15 or 16 years
All Age group high divers remain qualified from the 1st of January to midnight of the following 31st of December in the year of the competition.
Note: the divers at the age of 18 or 19 years would not be restricted from diving in the Senior events if they are competent to do so.
- J-HD 3.2** In all events three (3) competitors per Federation may be entered.

J-HD 4 FORMAT

- J-HD 4.1** Entries will be accepted regardless of standards.
- J-HD 4.2** The events will be held according to the World Aquatics High Diving Age Group Rules.
- J-HD 4.3** In case of a tie all tied divers will be ranked at the same place.

J-HD 5 ENTRIES

- HD 5.1** Preliminary Entries shall be submitted to the organising Federation, with copy to the European Aquatics Office, no later than the date circulated by the European Aquatics Office.
- HD 5.2** A Federation having made a Preliminary Entry may withdraw up to the date circulated by the European Aquatics Office.
- HD 5.3** Named Entries shall be submitted to the organising Federation, with copy to the European Aquatics Office, no later than ten (10) days before the first day of the competition, if not announced otherwise.
- HD 5.4** Competitors who cannot prove identity, age and citizenship shall not be permitted to take part in the competitions.

J-HD 6 ACCREDITATION

- J-HD 6.1** Federations entering the Championships will receive accreditation for:
- a) the President of the Federation;
 - b) the Head of the Delegation;
 - c) the entered competitors;
 - d) one medical person;
 - e) team staff members:
 - 5 for up to 5 competitors;
 - 6 for up to 9 competitors;
 - 7 for more than 9 competitors.
- J-HD 6.2** Team staff members include everybody servicing the team: Team Leaders, Coaches, Physiotherapists, etc., but not officials such as judges, referees, etc.

J-HD 7 AWARDS

- J-HD 7.1** Medals will be awarded to the competitors placed 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each event.
- J-HD 7.2** Diplomas will be awarded to the competitors placed 1st to 8th.

J-HD 8 OFFICIALS

- J-HD 8.1** The European Aquatics THDC shall appoint the Referee and the judges.
- J-HD 8.2** The costs for travel, accommodation and per diem for the appointed Referee and judges shall be divided by the number of entered athletes, multiplied by the number of athletes per Federation and covered accordingly by the participating Federations.
- J-HD 8.3** Assigned judges are not allowed to act as coaches throughout the actual Championships. Judges who do not respect this Regulation shall be excluded from the Championships.
- J-HD 8.4** Assigned judges may be evaluated.
