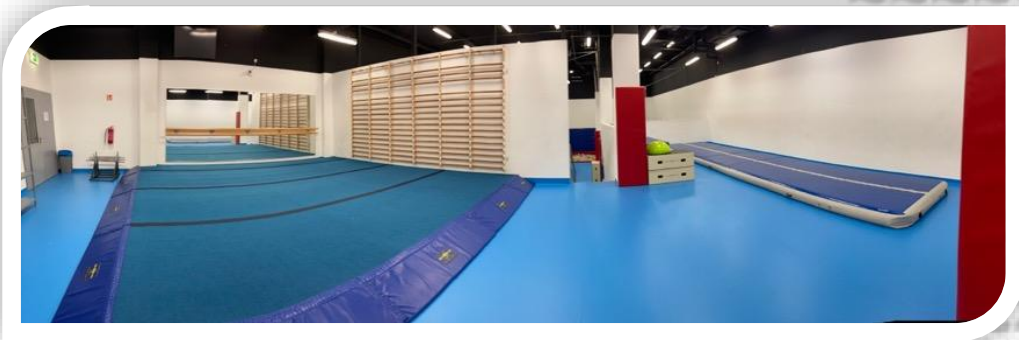
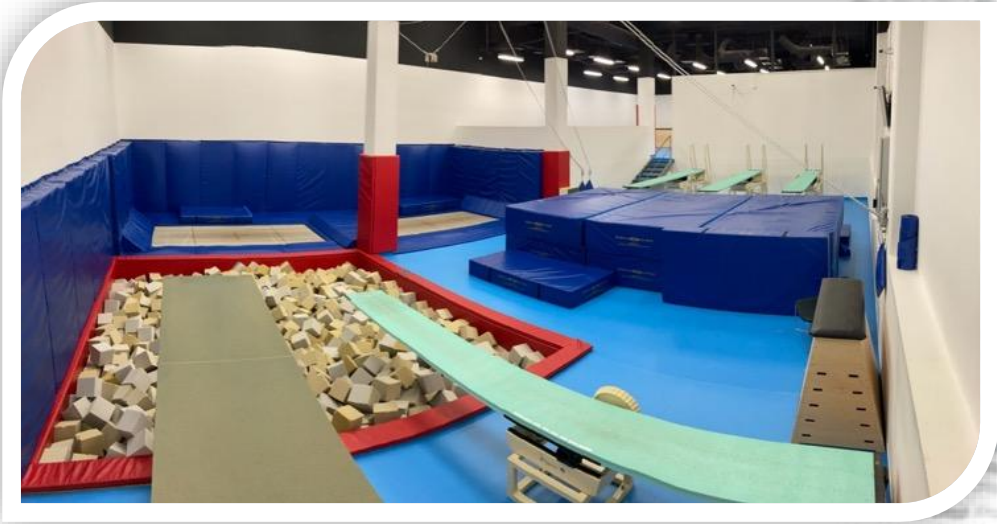

CEREMONIES

Athletes, Team Officials when participating in the Ceremonies mentioned below and the presentation proceeding the finals should wear National Team full kit (long sleeves, trousers, closed shoes) in respect to the official events, the equipment used should be compliant to European Aquatics Advertising Rules

Opening Ceremony

The opening ceremony will be held at the competition pool area on June 22, 2026, after the Mixed Team Final. Two athletes per country (one girl and one boy) must be present at the last call area. Further details will be confirmed at the Technical Meeting on June 21, 2026.

Medal Ceremonies

Medal Ceremonies will take place according to the competition schedule. Medals will be awarded to the athletes placed 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each event.

During the ceremony, medals will be presented, the national anthem of the gold medallist will be played, and the national flags of all medallists will be displayed on the scoreboard.

All athletes are reminded that attendance at the medal ceremonies is mandatory.

FURTHER INSIGHTS

Doping control and Medical services

Medical services will be available throughout the teams' stay in Budapest at the competition venue. Medical staff and ambulance car as well as lifeguards will be present on the pool deck during both practice and competitions.

Doping control will be conducted in accordance with the European Aquatics Medical Guidelines and the WADA International Standards.

NATIONAL FEDERATIONS' INSURANCE & RESPONSABILITY

The Insurance of the participants is the responsibility of the respective federations. All athletes are under the responsibility of their respective Team Leaders throughout the entire duration of the event. Team Leaders are responsible for the supervision of their athletes at all times, including outside the competition venue and when using public transportation or moving between official locations.



Visa Application

Participants are encouraged to contact the Hungarian Embassy or consulate in their country (or the nearest one) well in advance to check visa requirements. As processing times vary by region, please allow up to 45 days to obtain your visa.

To enable the LOC to issue an invitation letter, teams must provide their arrival and departure dates, accommodation details, the number of participants, and their full identities. To submit these, a visa application form must be requested from booking@hungariandiving.com. Kindly be advised that this information is required by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the relevant embassies, so we cannot proceed without it.

Please note that invitation letters are issued only after a valid hotel reservation has also been submitted or presented, as required by Hungarian law.

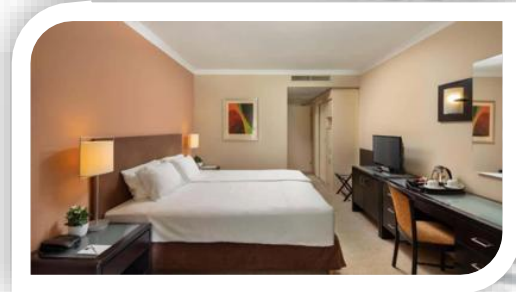

Accommodation Packages

The Local Organising Committee offers full board accommodation packages for official participants at the 4-star Hotel Verdi Budapest Aquincum, available at the following daily rates:

Single Room full board	220 EUR / person / night
Twin room full board	195 EUR / person /night



The hotel's restaurant provides buffet-style breakfast, lunch, and dinner. Each meal includes soup, a main course, dessert, a salad bar, and tap water. Dinner is the first meal included in the daily accommodation package on the day of arrival, while breakfast is the final meal included in the daily rate on the day of departure.

Please keep in mind that reservations will be accepted on a 'first-come, first-served' basis.

Check-in is from 15:00 and rooms must be vacated by 10:00 on the morning of departure. Upon request, the hotel will provide late check-out options or storage rooms for an additional fee, which should be paid directly to the property.

Disclaimer: the LOC does not take responsibility for any extra services provided by the hotel, such as minibar, laundry, etc. These costs are to be paid directly at the front desk.

How To Book?

To reserve a room, please complete the Hotel Reservation Form and return it to booking@hungariandiving.com as soon as possible, but no later than April 01, 2026.

Please be informed that European Aquatics has started a new partnership with WIZ-Team, an event management software provider, to support the organisation of European Aquatics Championships from this year onward.

The Junior Championships will be the first events to use the new system as part of its initial testing phase. Accommodation booking procedures and deadlines will remain unchanged.

To support the introduction of the system, National Federations are kindly asked to complete the accommodation forms in Excel (from now) and to enter further information needed into the new online platform, which will open in April.

We appreciate your cooperation and patience during this transition, which is expected to simplify and improve processes for all stakeholders in the future.

Special Request from the Local Organising Committee

As the new online system will only be introduced after the April 01 hotel reservation deadline, the Local Organising Committee kindly reminds all National Federations that, for this event the official and primary source of information for accommodation and transfer requests remains the Hotel Reservation Form and the Transfer Reservation Form. These forms must be completed and sent by email to booking@hungariandiving.com before April 01 (for hotel reservations) and May 15 (for transfer reservations) to ensure that all requests are received and processed in time.

Reservations will be handled strictly on a first-come, first-served basis. Once the forms are received, the LOC will confirm the bookings via email and issue a provisional pro forma invoice for verification prior to preparing any financial documents. For this reason, it is essential that Federations submit the required forms by the deadline before entering the same information into the new online platform once it becomes available.



IMPORTANT NOTICE

1.: Enquiries, bookings, and payments will be accepted from National Federations exclusively in particular from the officially appointed representatives.

Accommodation services cannot be ordered or paid for by any other party or individual, by the National Federation only, therefore one joint pro forma invoice will be issued per National Federation respectively. Any further financial accounting settlements are a subject to the National Federations responsibility.

Kindly be reminded that the Accommodation Packages include complimentary airport transfer. To secure your seats, please complete the Airport Transfer Form and send it to booking@hungariandiving.com by 15 May 2026.

2.: National Federations booking their accommodation outside the official hotel of the Championships may be subject to an **operational fee per person/per day** to cover various services, provided within Championships participation.

Cancellation Policy

Should you cancel or modify your hotel booking, a charge will be made equivalent to any loss suffered by the Local Organising Committee, as itemised below. The amount of the cancellation fee will be calculated as a percent of the accommodation package fee according to the following period of notice given:

No cancellation fee, if cancelled until	01 April 2026
50% of cancellation fee, if cancelled between	02 April – 01 May 2026
100% of cancellation fee, if cancelled	after 02 May 2026

Please, note that in case you submit your room reservation after the reservation deadline (01 April 2026) and LOC can confirm your request, the relevant cancellation terms will come into effect immediately from the moment of your reservation.

PAYMENT TERMS

The accommodation package fees are to be paid as follows:

As outlined above, the hotel reservation deadline is April 01, 2026. Once the LOC confirms your booking, 60% of the total amount will be invoiced with an 8-day payment term, while the remaining 40% is due by June 01, 2026.

The booking will remain **provisional until the payment of the invoice** has been received on Local Organising Committee (LOC) bank account provided.



The LOC reserves the right to alter or cancel the reservation until payment will be accounted. Upon receipt of the payment, the reservation becomes confirmed. An updated proforma invoice will be sent to respective National Federation verifying the arrival of the payment the LOC received.

Airport transfer fees for participants with an individual hotel reservation must be paid in full amount by June 01, 2026.

Transportation

Airport and railway transfers are managed as part of the accommodation package. Travel time from the airport to the hotel is about 45 minutes (pending on traffic). From the three different main train stations it takes about 30 minutes to the hotel.

Local Organising Committee will offer limited transportation services between the official hotel and the venue. However, the venue is conveniently located within a 25-minute walking distance or can be reached in approximately 12 minutes via public transportation (1 stop) through the Arpad bridge. The Local Organising Committee will provide public transport tickets in addition to the accreditation card as part of the accommodation package.

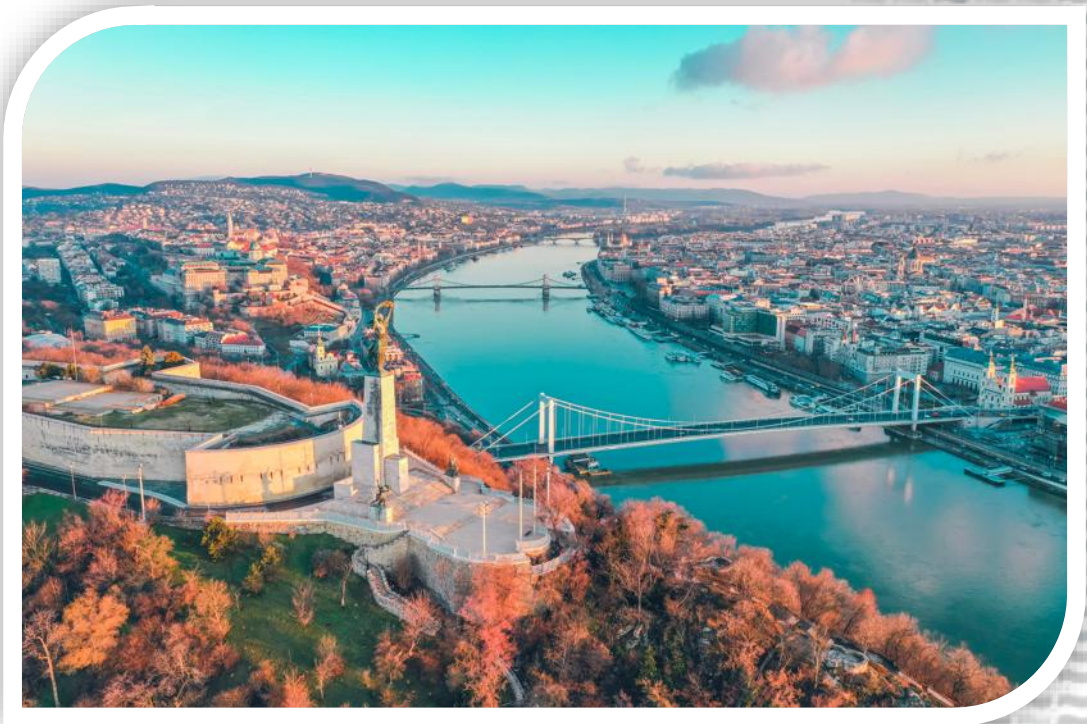
HUNGARY AT A GLANCE

GENERAL INFORMATION ON HUNGARY

Hungary is a landlocked country in Central Europe surrounded by Slovakia, Ukraine, Romania, Serbia, Croatia, Slovenia and Austria. The Danube River forms part of Hungary's north-western border with Slovakia, and then flows south through Budapest, dividing Hungary into two general regions. A low, rolling plain known as the Great Hungarian Plain, covers most of the region east of the Danube extending east to Romania and south to Serbia. Hungary has a continental climate with cold, cloudy, humid winters and warm to hot summers. Average annual temperature is 9.7 °C (49.5F). Temperature extremes are about 38 °C (100F) in the summer and -29°C (-20F) in the winter. Average temperature in the summer is 27 to 32 °C (81 to 90F). The average yearly rainfall is approximately 600mm (24 in).

CITY OF BUDAPEST



Budapest, the capital of Hungary, is one of Europe's most captivating cities, shaped by a thousand years of history and the majestic flow of the Danube. The city unites the elegant hills of Buda with the vibrant, cosmopolitan energy of Pest, creating a setting where architectural heritage and modern urban life blend seamlessly. Visitors can explore grand boulevards,



historic thermal baths, UNESCO-listed riverfronts, and a cultural scene that reflects both tradition and innovation.

Renowned for its hospitality and long-standing sporting culture, Budapest has hosted numerous international events and continues to welcome athletes and teams from around the world. With its excellent infrastructure, diverse culinary landscape, and lively atmosphere, the city offers an inspiring environment for competition and an unforgettable experience for all participants.
